



Market Outlook and Investment Strategy

The global markets surprisingly digested the unexpected event "Brexit" quickly. Thanks to the excessive easing policies from most of the central banks, the money supply remained ample in major markets. The US S&P500 Index reached new high in this year; and the US treasury yield remained at historical low level. Even though the Bank of England held the interest rate unchanged for July, it was still highly expected that BOE will cut the interest rate in August. The commodity prices remained volatile amid the increasing uncertainty. China's 1H16 macro figures were lukewarm but in-line. Declining YTD FAI investments growth (9.7%) but steady YTD retail sales growth (10.6%) may indicate the economic restructuring is still on the way. Monetary supply remained ample as the New Yuan Loans reached 1.38 trillion in June. The SOE reform again was the major task for the central government in 2H16. We expected to see more concrete M&A deals between the central SOEs.
