



Market Outlook and Investment

US stock market got hit hard during the past month, with Dow Jones corrected by 6.67%, while S&P 500 dropped by 6.58%, and Nasdag tumbled by 7.93%. The U.S. macro economy reported disappointing data, notably the ISM Manufacturing Index of May was 52.1, which bears the consensus of 53, and inflation also picked up to 2% from previous 1.9%. The U.S. president's announcement of tariffs on Chinese and Mexican imports in May caused risk assets to deliver the worst month of performance this year to date. Sovereign bonds rallied across the developed world, where the results of the European Parliamentary elections set up conditions for escalating tensions. Along with generally underwhelming economic data, the ratcheting higher of geopolitical risk sparked a collapse in investor sentiment.

China official manufacturing PMI in May was 49.4, which dropped to contraction area, while the Export growth dropped sharply to -2.7% from previous 14.2%. CPI increased to 2.5% in April, which was the highest rate since October last year, mainly due to a surge in prices of food as an outbreak of African swine fever sent the price of pork soaring. The reheated Sino-US trade dispute has again become the market focus, which smashed the market sentiment thoroughly. As for the stock market, the CSI300 corrected by 7.24% to 3,629.8. In regard to our investment strategy for Hong Kong/China market, as trade war developments suggest that a rebound in global trade and capex later in the year are less likely, we would like to look for some stabilization in momentum before considering an further underweight, though we are more circumspect than a month ago, owing to the fact we've already have defensive cash level. We believe in longer term the fundamental results will act as the major driver of market direction, and we would position ourselves accordingly.
